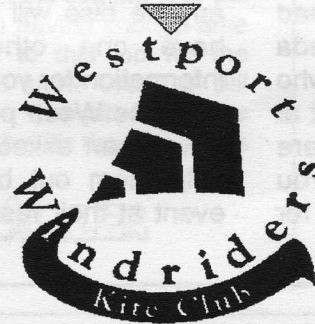
Summer Festival Issue
